Why It Is Important

Daily Planet Health Services (DPHS) has more than 120 employees at its three locations. From performing outreach to homeless individuals on the street to checking patients into our clinic to providing care and support in our clinics and residential facilities, most employees work on the front lines of for the organization.

These jobs can put our staff at higher risk for illness and stress. They work long hours helping thousands of

patients each year deal with one or more challenging or even life-threatening issues, including physical illnesses, mental health and addiction conditions, housing instability and more.

Suggested Materials

If you would like to donate a meal, it is logistically easier to donate funds for us to schedule, purchase and distribute meals to our locations.

- \$100 - cold breakfast (bagels, OJ) or lunch (pizza w/drinks)
- \$200 - hot breakfast (sandwiches, coffee, OJ), or lunch (Jimmy John's boxed lunch w/drinks)
- \$300 - custom boxed lunch (Panera, Jason's Deli, etc.)

However you decide to raise the funds to donate is up to you. You can do an online fundraising campaign, visit your neighborhood using appropriate safety measures, write letters to friends and family.
